## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entries will be received by the Show Secretary subject to the rules and regulations of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd. and those hereinafter set out.
2. Exhibitors shall at all times abide by the Rules and conditions as laid down by the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Inc.
3. All exhibitors shall be bound by and observe the decisions of the ground jury.
4. The show ground jury reserves the right to adjudicate upon entry or upon any dispute or doubt and to make any determination up on any matter and this decision shall be final and not subject to appeal of any kind.
5. The Society shall have the power without assigning any reason to:
  - i. Reject or cancel any entry at any time
  - II. Cancel any event or class
  - III. Remove any exhibit from the show grounds
  - IV. Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another class
  - V. Add to or alter the program as necessary
  - VI. Combine classes if there are insufficient entries
6. The Society shall not be responsible for the loss or for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or the property of any exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
7. The Exhibitor enters entirely at his/her own risk. Insurance rules apply.
8. In case any exhibit whilst on the Society's showground shall cause or be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or exhibitor, to the person or property of any member of the Society or general public, the owner of such exhibit shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Society, its officers, officials and members, from and against all damages, costs, claims, expenses or liabilities incurred in connection with such exhibitors. The Exhibitor shall be liable to the Society and its employees, officers and officials for any damage or loss occasioned to any of them by the Exhibitor or his agent.
9. All ponies four years and over must be adult registered.
10. All ponies under four years must either be adult registered or foal recorded.
11. All ponies competing must be visibly branded and registered with the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd., and owners/exhibitors must be current financial members of the Society.
12. Ponies cannot be shown under saddle until three years of age.
13. Handlers and riders of stallions and colts must be 18 years of age and over.
14. All ponies are required to be measured. Current measuring certificates issued by any EA, SHC or any Royal Show will be accepted.
15. All exhibitors must carry RPSBS Ltd. registration certificates with them and must be made available on request.
16. There is to be NO change of handler once a class has commenced without the permission of the judge.
17. The Judge's decision will be final.
18. No person shall in any way consult or interfere with or attempt to interfere with the Judge or endeavor to interfere with the Judge's freedom of choice or judgment.
19. The Society may alter the Judge for any particular event at any time it deems fit.
20. Approved helmets must be worn at all times whilst riding. Any injury sustained by a person riding and not wearing an approved helmet will not be covered by any liability claim or by insurance. Approved helmets are as follows AS/NZS3838, EN 1384 or ASTN F1163.
21. A fall of a horse and/or rider in a ridden event will result in disqualification from that event.
22. A rider must NOT remount in the show ring following a fall.
23. Random swabbing may take place.
24. Disputes/protests must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class, together with a deposit of \$55.00 (md. GST) refundable if the protest is upheld.
25. Membership and registration papers must be with the owner on the day of the show.
26. No pending registrations, no late memberships will be accepted.
27. Newcomer Ponies Rules — See RPSBS Ltd website [www.rpsbs.com](http://www.rpsbs.com) for all Rules & Regulations. Each pony must have a newcomer Card. Newcomer Cards must be given to the Ring Steward when entering the ring. If competitor does not produce their Newcomer Card they will not be able to compete. Newcomer Ponies are not eligible for any other Ridden Classes if they wish to compete at the Riding Pony Horse of the Year or the Riding Pony Nationals in Newcomer classes. Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
28. If the show is cancelled then 50% of the entry fee only will be refunded.

If you are not a Current Financial Member of the RPSBS Ltd or a Current Financial EFA Member or any affiliated Society with the EFA, you must pay the \$20.00 Public Liability Insurance Cover for the day or your entries will not be accepted. THIS ALSO APPLIES TO ANY PERSON ASSISTING COMPETITORS ON THE DAY. ALL MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT THE ATTACHED INSURANCE FORMS.
